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What was the result of the way the early believers lived in the world around them (see Acts 2:47)? Does the current church still have the same impact?
What needs to shift in your life to start to create that?

What makes this interconnected life and cultural impact possible (see Matt.28:20 & Acts 2:38)?

What can we learn about God in this passage?

What might God be calling you to do with what you've learned this week?
