Read Malachi 1-4

Malachi 1:6 speaks of fathers and masters. Which more closely fits with your view of God? Why do you think that is?

What did God speak against in 1:6-14? When have you offered something similar?

How might your view of God from the first question inform and influence how or what you present when you offer to God, as in the second question?

The Lord speaks against the people of Judah in 2:10-14 for being unfaithful to Him with foreign gods. How has the American church been unfaithful in a similar way? What gods has the Church turned to, and intermarried with, as opposed to being faithful to God alone?

For you personally, in what ways have you intermarried with other gods, either of the culture, or of self, as opposed to being faithful to God alone?

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What kind of offspring is God referring to in 2:15, and what is He calling His people to?

What can we learn about our perception of scarcity and abundance from 3:6-12?

Where do we see glimpses of Jesus in Malachi?

What can we learn about God in Malachi?

What might you feel the Spirit prompting you to do in response to Malachi's message?
