### **Growth Group Opener:**

***What is your favorite job you've ever had? Why was it your favorite?***

**Read: Genesis 2: 1-15; Genesis 3: 17-19; Colossians 3: 23-24**

Why do you think God made work a part of His original perfect plan for us and our world?

How did work change once sin entered the world?

Do you view your job as holy work, as care for a part of God's world, or do you view it more as toil?

Within a framework of work being a gift to us from God, and our work being an offering back to Him, are there truly any jobs that are more holy than others? Explain.

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If you approached your job as if you were working only for God:  
What would change in *the way* you perform your work?  
What would change in *how you feel* about your work?  
What would change in *the way you interact with* your co-workers?

What can we learn about God from these passages?

Is there anything you feel the Holy Spirit nudging you to look at more closely in your life?

How can you shift your work from being more about making a living, to more about making a difference for the Kingdom of God?
