***What did it feel like once you realized you were lost?***

How might the sheep in this story have gotten lost?

Why might the shepherd have chosen to go after a singular sheep, when he had 99 others still in his care?

What happened when the sheep was found?

Why do you think this was such a big deal?

What can we learn about God from this passage?

If you take an honest look at your heart, do you align more with the Pharisees at the beginning of the story, or with the joy-filled people at the end?

In light of this passage, how should we, ourselves, respond to someone we see who has wandered off, or who is far from God?

Is there anything you feel the Holy Spirit nudging you to look at more closely?
