The next few weeks, we will be talking about different buzzwords used often in church. Many church songs contain terms that can be confusing if you're unfamiliar with them. Have you ever misheard lyrics in a song or hymn? How did you think the line went?

Read: John 1:1-3 & Genesis 1:1-2

What do these two passages tell us about the Trinity?

Read: Romans 8: 1-39

How did God give believers new life in His Spirit, setting us free from sin and death?

What is the believer's role in living by the Spirit and not the flesh?
How is this accomplished?

How do we see the Father, Son, and Spirit working together?

Do the Father, Son, and Spirit have the same purpose and the same agenda?
Explain your thinking.



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How do the Father, Son and Spirit surround a believer, according to these passages?

How might this chapter of Scripture reframe the good and bad of our day to day lives?

What does the interaction of the Trinity provide for a believer in v.37-39?

Are you utilizing what has been provided to you, according to what you've read here?

What can we learn about God from this incredibly rich chapter?

Is there anything you feel the Holy Spirit nudging you to look at more closely in Romans 8? In your own life?
